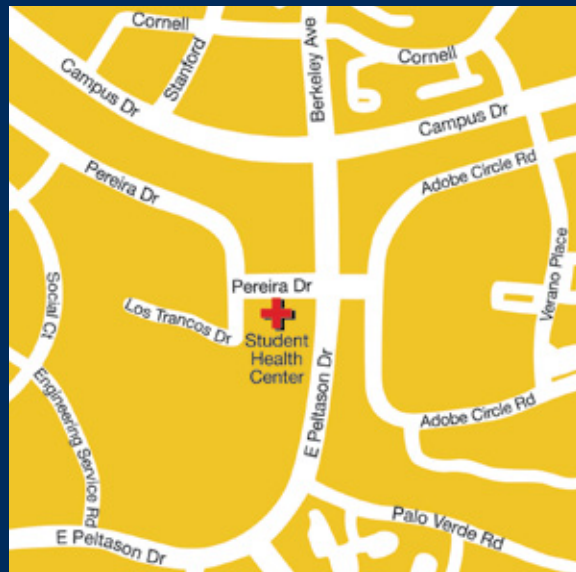

What Is the UC Irvine Student Health Center?

- The Student Health Center is a comprehensive outpatient clinic staffed with licensed physicians, nurses and other health care professionals.

Counseling and Mental Health

- Counseling for study problems, relationship concerns, anxiety, depression and other stress-related issues.

Dental Clinic

- Full and comprehensive dental services offered such as examinations, dental x-rays, fillings bondings, teeth whitening, crown and bridgework.
- Our Dental Specialists provide dental implants, oral surgery, periodontal surgery and endodontic (root canal treatment) services.
- Free consultations with an Orthodontist are also available.
- Dental Clinic accepts USHIP and most other dental insurance.

Eye Clinic

Available for registered students and their spouses. Comprehensive eye exams, soft, gas-permeable and disposable contact lenses, plus a variety of frame styles available, all at discounted prices.

Pharmacy

Prescriptions written by Student Health or personal physicians may be filled at the Student Health Pharmacy. Prices are competitive with outside commercial pharmacies.

Our Pharmacy contracts with a large number of insurance plans providing pharmaceutical coverage to subscribers.

What About Insurance?

The Regents of the University of California require students to have health insurance coverage as a non-academic condition to enrollment for undergraduates. Mandatory health insurance for graduate students was approved by graduate student referendum. Health insurance is included in student fees. Enrollment in a Student Health Insurance Plan (USHIP for undergraduates or GSHIP for graduate students) is automatic.

You may waive out of your SHIP by demonstrating comparable and verifiable health coverage that meets the campus minimum standards for insurance. A copy of the applicable Student Health Insurance Plan, and appropriate waiver instructions, are available on the Student Health Center website at www.shc.uci.edu.

The Student Health Center is the primary care facility for students covered under USHIP or GSHIP. Under this plan, all medical care must be initiated at the Student Health Center. If we do not provide a specific medical service, you will be referred to a qualified provider in the community.

If you are covered by USHIP or GSHIP, the cost of your medical care will be billed directly to your insurance plan after applicable deductibles or co-payments are met. Students who have their own health insurance and have already waived out of USHIP or GSHIP must pay at the time of service. Student Health Center will give you an itemized receipt to submit to your insurance carrier for reimbursement.
